## Answering questions related to repeated enrollment and credit calculation toward Graduation



### Repeated Enrollment

In case you received a grade of C or C+ for major course(s), you may repeat enrollment for the course(s).

#### **Credit Calculation toward Graduation**

If a course is enrolled more than once, only the credit of the most recent enrollment is counted toward graduation, **except** when the course is allowed by the university to be enrolled more than once. The total sum of course credits is counted toward graduation.

### **Example**

Repeated enrollment in major course, e.g. the student receives a grade of C+ from the first attempt

- If the second enrollment is withdrawn (a grade of W), the previous grade (C+) and course credit will be calculated and counted toward graduation.
- If the student receives an F grade from second enrollment, they must re-enroll in the course and pass the evaluation because an F grade **cannot** be counted toward graduation. However, it will be calculated in cumulative GPA.
- Other than that, re-enrollment in courses that are allowed by the university to be enrolled more than once, e.g. Selected Topic courses, all credits from this course will be counted toward graduation.


# Ratio of CMU female students
