Let REG tell you how to change your student record

What can I change or add to my student record?

- 1. First name, middle name, surname
- 2. The spelling of the name in English or Thai
- 3. National ID number, passport number, and nationality
- 4. Student's address. For undergraduates, only the parent's addresses can be adjusted.
- 5. Title or Rank, only for graduate students.
- 6. Parent's information
- 7.Phone number

Where can I have my student record changed?

- 1.On the Registration System by signing in with **CMU Account**
- 2. At the Registration Counter Service

What documents should I submit for information adjustment?

- 1. A copy of the Certificate of Name Change and National ID Card for the change of name.
- 2. A copy of the Certificate of Residence Registration with the parent's name for change of address.
- 3. Other relevant documents for adjustment of national ID/passport number and change of nationality


What can I do to help speed up the checking and saving new information?

You must attach files of relevant documents in readable formats such as .jpg or .pdf. Be careful while inputting new information in the name-surname fields. After you get an email to make the adjustment, you will only need to access the URL given in the email. All in all, it usually takes 24 hours before the adjusted information appears on websites.
