The Registration Office offers new tuition fee paying methods for convenience. Students can now pay tuition fee via Alipay and WeChat Pay with 1.7% processing fee.

Those who pay the tuition fee with KBANK Credit Cards can put it on a 3-month installment program with 0% interest. Processing fee of 2.1% online credit card payment or 0.9% at the Finance Division CMU (unable to pay in installments) may apply.

Oh No... My Enrolled Course Disappeared!! Reasons Why REG Removes Course from Your Enrollment

Some of you may wonder why a course(s) suddenly disappear from the list of enrolled courses. Here are the reasons why:

- 1. **Not meeting prerequisites**: if the student does not meet course prerequisites, REG will remove the course from your enrollment. Examples: Student A enrolls in course 206162 with 206161 as a prerequisite. If Student A has not completed 206161 yet, 206162 will be removed.
- 2. Repeated enrollment in a course/similar course which the student has completed with a grade of C, S, CE, CP, CS, CT, CX or equivalent or above is considered invalid. Therefore, the course will be removed from your enrollment by REG.
 - Except when you re-enroll in major course(s) from which you earned a grade of C or C+.
- 3. Repeated enrollment in a course from which the student was granted a grade of I or P. No need to re-enroll in an ongoing course or to receive evaluation or assessment from the course.
