REG's Guide on Course Withdrawal (Receiving a W Grade)



Students who wish to withdraw from course(s) this semester can submit their requests via the Online Registration Systems until February 24, 2023!

Sign in to the Registration Systems with your CMU Mail then select "Menu" > "Course withdrawal with a W grade." After selecting the course(s) and the reason for withdrawal, don't forget to carefully review your request when the summary of the course(s) to withdraw shows up. Then you must click on the "Click to confirm your request" button to complete your part of the process.

How can I know if the course withdrawal process is completed?

🕗 You will receive a withdrawal confirmation in your CMU Mail.

How long would it take? Who approves it?

The course withdrawal request will be forwarded to your advisor for approval. The result should be expected within 5 business days.

How can I follow up on the request?

Sign in to the Registration Systems with your CMU Mail. There are 3 withdrawal statuses as follows:

> Green is "approval." Red is "disapproved." Yellow is "See your adviser."

Can Graduate Students Switch from Visitors (a V grade) to **Normal Enrollment (Evaluation** and Assessment)?

Graduate students who have enrolled as visitors (a V grade) in graduate-level courses may change their visiting status to normal enrollment (evaluation and assessment) by submitting a general request form to the student's affiliated faculty. The request must be approved by the instructor, the advisor and the department head. After receiving approvals, the student may submit the general request form with a copy of the Visiting Form (CMR 46) at the Registration Counter Service of the Registration Office, or ask the faculty staff to submit it through the documentation system from February 27 - March 3, 2023.
