Registration as A Student for New Graduate Student ID 66, Semester 1/2023 (1st round)

Applicants who have been selected to study at CMU must register as a student on the Registration Office's website at https://cmu.to/vcAIQ. The system will be opened for record completion and making a flat-rate tuition fee payment on Wednesday, March 1, 2023 from 8AM to 11PM.

In case

- 1. <u>The student receives a scholarship</u>: the student must contact their affiliated department/faculty for a tuition fee payment extension form and submit it to the Graduate Record Section of the Registration Office.
- 2. The student is <u>in process of selection for the CMU Presidential scholarship</u> (CMU PS) or Teaching Assistant/Research Assistant (TA/RA) Scholarship: the student proceeds to register on Friday, June 16, 2023 instead.

How Much GPAX Should I Get to Keep My Student Status?

Students may lose their status if their grade point result does not meet the following criteria.

Noted that this only applies to a regularly enrolled semester and **excludes** the semester on which leave of absence is taken.

- 1. When the student finishes two regular semesters* with a GPA lower than 1.50.
- 2. When the student finishes four regular semesters* with a GPA lower than 1.75.
- 3. When the student finishes more than four regular semesters* and receives a GPA lower than 1.75 for two consecutive semesters.
- 4. Having a GPAX lower than 2.00 obtained from regular enrollment, credit transfer, or equivalent credit transfer (except for grade W), including grades S, U, V, CE, CP, CS, CT and CX.

In this case, the total accumulated credit already exceeds 240 for a 4-year program, 300 for a 5-year program, and 360 for a 6year program respectively.

*Regular Semester refers to the first or second semester of each academic year.


