## Can students enroll in more than the maximum number of credits?

Students who expect to graduate within the 2/2022 semester can enroll in **more than 22 credits** (for undergraduates) or **more than 15 credits** (for graduates) upon the Dean's approval. Students must submit a request form to their affiliated departments/faculties from November 21 to December 1, 2022, so that it can be forwarded to the Registration Office prior to the final course enrollment processing on December 2, 2022.

### Let's talk about Course Prerequisite and Enrollment



#### What is a prerequisite?

A prior condition for enrolling in a certain course. Students are not allowed to enroll for a course unless all prerequisite is completed.

#### Check for course prerequisites on Reg Website

Students can review the course description, including prerequisites, under the "Course Description" menu tab. Once the registration process is complete, check to see if a red "Not pass PRE" tab appears under the course in your registration list.

#### No use enrolling in courses with unmet prerequisites

Though enrollment in certain courses is processed, it is ultimately deemed void. Enrolled courses with unmet prerequisites will be removed. If students do not drop the courses within the designated time, they will receive a letter grade "W" instead

#### What if I receive a grade I/P for prerequisite courses?

You may enroll in the sequel courses but... you must replace the grade I/P with any letter grade **except** for F/U or else the enrollment of the sequel courses is deemed void and a grade "W" is awarded.

#### Check CMR.50 before paying the tuition fee

FINAL CHECK your list of enrolled courses in CMR.50 report before paying your tuition fee. By the way, the enrollment is considered successful after the University receives the proof of payment.



#### Transferring Credit from Credit bank

For the 2/2022 semester, the Credit Transfer System (CMU-LE) will be open for undergraduate students from November 14 to December 1, 2022.




#### Edu and Med Students Graduation Status for Semester 1/2022
