Get Ready !! Degree Certification (Digital Document) Open for Request Starting June 17, 2024

- **Digital** Degree Certification
 - Student **IDs 50 or newer** takes 1 business day to prepare
 - Student **IDs before 50** takes 3 business days to prepare (the system will send the digital document to emails provided)
- **Physical/Paper** Degree Certification
 - Student **IDs 50 or newer** **the duration is lessen** from 3 business days to **1 business day**.
 - Student **IDs before 50** takes 3 business days to prepare (exclude the duration of postal delivery)

Noted that tuition fees are **not refundable**.

Methods of tuition fee payment:

1. QR Payment (no fee)
2. Online credit card payment (2.1% fee)
3. Alipay / WeChat pay (1.7% fee)
4. Pay at the Finance Division of CMU
 - debit card* (no fee)
 - credit card* (0.9% fee)
 - cashier cheque issued to "Chiang Mai University"

* Please check your available limit before attempting payment.

Selected candidates who do not register on the date specified will be **void of the rights to study**. The University will later call individuals in the list of reserves up to register.

Remarks

- Students who are granted scholarships must contact their affiliated departments/faculties **7 days before the date of new student registration** to sign letters of tuition fee waiver, which will later be forwarded to the Registration Office.
- Faculties/Colleges need to forward the lists of individuals who wish to return to being Chiang Mai University graduate students in the year 2024, as well as the amount of fees, to the Registration Office **at least 7 days before the date of new student registration**. And the students will need to pay the tuition fees in full amount on the day of registration.

English Proficiency Testing for New Undergraduate Students of Chiang Mai University (CMU-ePro) of Academic Year 2024

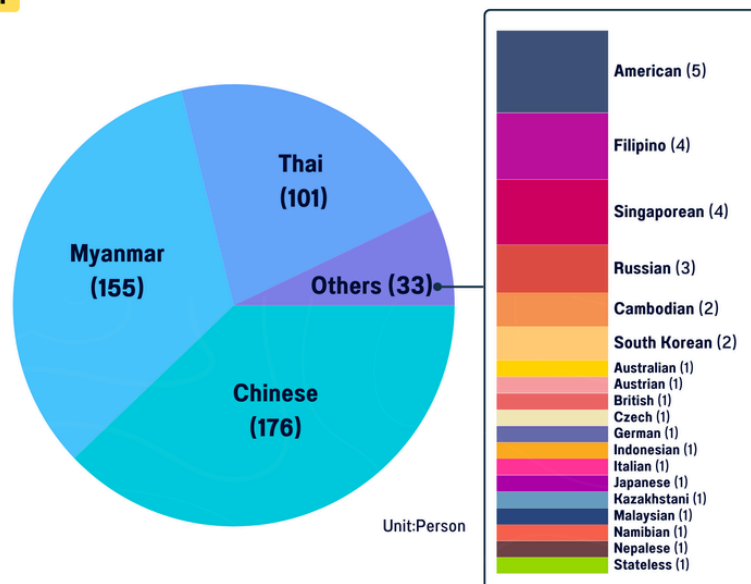
