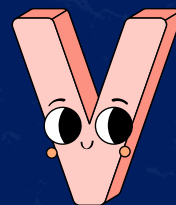

# Requesting for a Grade of V (Visiting)

## Semester 1/2024



July 15, 2024 09.00 A.M. - July 19, 2024 11.59 P.M.

A grade of V (Visiting) is when you are enrolling in a course as a “visitor,” which means you do not need to get assessed and evaluated for the course. However, if you do not attend the class for more than 80% of total class time, or do not follow course requirements, the instructor might consider changing the grade of V to a grade of W.

A request for a grade of V is considered complete when approvals from the Advisor, the Instructor and the Head of department. If not, the status shown in the system will be “Incomplete”.

**Remarks** Students with IDs 66 or higher do not need to seek approval from the Head of the Department.

If the status shows “Complete (V)”, the request for a grade of V is successful.

## REG-FAQ ?

### How Much GPA Do I Need to Stay Safe from Being Retired?

Your student status shall be terminated (Retire) if you have one of the following academic results:

1. a GPA of **less than 1.50** after having enrolled for two regular semester.\*
2. a GPA of **less than 1.75** after having enrolled for four regular semester.\*
3. a GPA of **less than 1.75 for two consecutive regular semesters**, after having enrolled for four regular semesters or over.\*
4. a GPA of **less than 2.00** after having obtained 240 credits in a 4-year program, or 300 credits in a 5-year program, or 360 credits in a 6-year program. (Courses which were awarded with grades of W are excluded.)\*

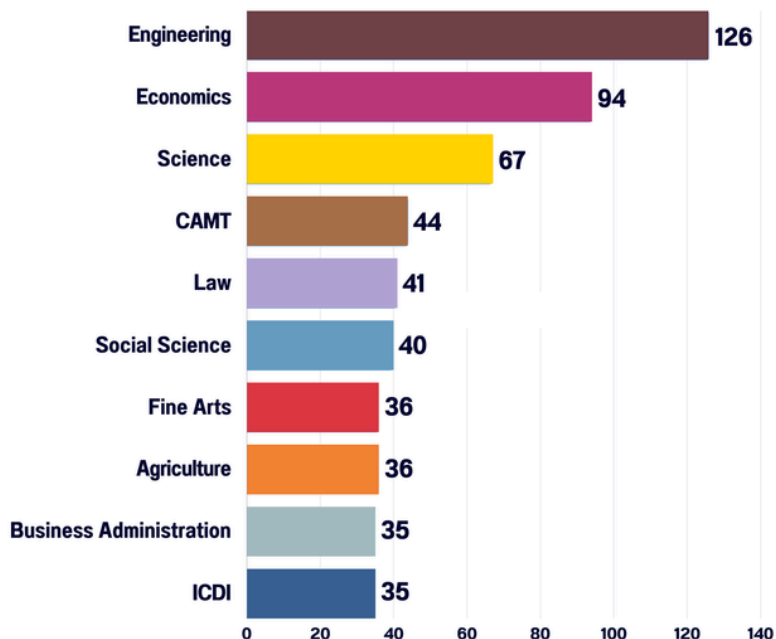
\* Regular semesters are semester 1 and semester 2 of each academic year. **Only semesters with enrollment information are counted.** Semesters in which leaves of absents are taken are not counted toward the criteria.
