# REG-FAQ ?... Can Undergraduate Students Repeat a Course?


#### Undergraduate students may repeat a course under certain conditions:


In case of repeating a major course, you must previously have received a grade of C+ or lower (F, D, D+, C).

In case you wish to repeat a <u>non-major course</u>, you must previously have received a grade of D+ or lower (F, D).

#### Attention !!

When a course is enrolled more than one time, only the latest enrollment in the course is counted toward graduation. For example, if Nong Mhee repeated the 111 course and received a grade of F, Nong Mhee will have to re-enroll until they receives a passing grade. However, all grade points earned from course repetition will be calculated in their Cumulative Grade Point Average.
