I Lost My Student ID Card. What Should I do?

The first thing you must do when you realize that you lost your student ID card is to cancel and freeze the old card through SCB Call Center (+66)2-777-7777



Next, you can request for a new student ID card by either one of the two methods:

Through SCB Easy App (free of charge)

- 1. Request for a new student ID card in the Registration Systems Menu >> "Request for Student Identity Card". The Registration Office will send the request information to the bank each Friday at 9.00 A.M. and the information will be updated on SCB. the following Wednesday.
- 2. Apply for a new card through the SCB Easy App. The card will be delivered within 3 weeks.

At the counter of SCB CMU Branches (fees may apply)

- 1. Get a student ID card request form
 - 1.1 from the Registration Systems Menu >> "Request for Student Identity Card," then print out the request form or
 - 1.2 by visiting the Registration Counter Service to get a card request form
- 2. Bring the card request form, along with your passport, to SCB (CMU Branch or Faculty of Medicine Branch) to apply for a new card.

REG-ALERT

Second-year students or higher of any majors who wish to apply for a COTMES test must be approved for resignation before September 10, 2024. (Resignation documents must be forwarded to the Registration Office before September 5, 2024.) For first-year students of the Faculty of Medicine I Dentistry / Veterinary Medicine / Pharmacy who wish to re-admit into their current faculties, your resignation must be approved by the University before April 25, 2025. (Resignation documents must be forwarded to the Registration Office before April 21, 2025.) If you do not resign within the following deadlines, you will not be able to apply for the COTMES test.
