# Verification of the prerequisite of course registration in the semester 2/2024

Students can check the status on the registration page. The system will display the status as follows:

- If a green bar appears, the prerequisite is fulfilled, and you can register for that course.
- If a <u>red bar</u> appears and there is no "or/and consent" message, it means the prerequisite is not fulfilled. The registration for that course will be invalid, and the course will be removed.

In the semester 2/2024, the Registration Office will remove courses that do not pass the prerequisites on November 9, 2024. Please remember to check your registration status after this date.

# New student registration for graduate student, Code 67, Semester 2/2024


Admitted graduate students must register online at <a href="https://cmu.to/gradstd">https://cmu.to/gradstd</a> and pay the fees by Wednesday, November 6, 2024, between 8:30 AM and 11:00 PM.

Exception: Students who meet the criteria for re-admission to Chiang Mai University must submit their intent documents to the relevant department at least 7 working days before the registration date and must pay all required fees.

Admitted students who do not register within the specified period will be considered to have forfeited their admission. The university will then notify the next eligible candidate on the waiting list to register.

#### Note:

- Paid tuition fees are nonrefundable.
- For scholarship students, please coordinate with your department/faculty (at least one week before the registration date) to request a deferral of tuition fee payment on the registration day.



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
