Registration for Graduation for Undergraduate Student, Semester 2/2022

- Students expecting to graduate **Semester 2/2022** must register for graduation at <https://cmu.to/reggrad> from December 5, 2022 9 A.M. to December 9, 2022 4 P.M.
- Students registered for graduation during **Semester 1/2022** can check graduation status at <https://cmu.to/reggrad> from December 8, 2022 onwards.

Where can I check the enrollment result?

On December 4, 2022, students will receive the Course Enrollment Form (CMR50) on (1) CMU Mail or (2) the Registration Office's website by signing in with CMU Account > "enrollment result/pay tuition fee"

What to do after receiving the enrollment result?

You must **confirm** the course enrollment result. Go through the list of courses enrolled and check the course numbers, sections, and schedules. Otherwise, you will **be unable** to print out the semester's course enrollment form. Students who took the student loan must also confirm their enrollment results.

Where can I pay the tuition fee and obtain the receipt?

- **Pay via Thai QR Payment or credit card** you can print out the receipt with an electronic signature from the Registration Systems by signing in with CMU Account. This receipt can be submitted for tuition fee reimbursement.
- **Pay at any bank** print out the CMR50 Form and make a payment at the teller. After the payment is made, the form will be signed and stamped. This original receipt can also be submitted for tuition fee reimbursement. If the original receipt is lost, you must report to the police department and bring a copy of the report to contact the CMU Finance Division to obtain a copy.
- **Student Loan or Scholarship** for those who take a full student loan, sign into the Registration Systems with your CMU Account, select "enrollment result/pay tuition fee" then print out the receipt. For other scholarships, please contact the CMU Finance Division.
