FIRST DECADE (1964-1973)

"ACADEMIC RECORDS AND PROCESSING SECTION"

was established alongside the foundation of the University in 1964. The Registration Department was a unit under the General Division, Office of the President, with a mission to to support Chiang Mai University's educational management as a Comprehensive University.

Later in 1966, Chiang Mai University separated its Registration Department, and established the "Academic <u>Services Division</u>" under the Office of the President in preparation to support the expansion of the university.

THE SECOND DECADE (1974-1983)

"Academic Record and Processing Section" had brought innovations to the procedure of course enrollment, beginning with Individual Course Enrollment Permit Forms (orange cards). The cards were used to seek permission to enroll from authorized persons of each faculty. The order of enrollment was considered by the last digits of student ID numbers. This system is often referred by CMU graduates as the "<u>Race Horse</u>" system.

THE THIRD DECADE (1984-1993)

Later on, the <u>Punching Card</u> system was utilized. The enrollment cards were gathered and sent to Chulalongkorn University to process. The data would then be imported into the VAX-11/750 computer at the Computer Services Center.

In 1986, computer technology was adopted to further improve the enrollment system. The Punching Card system was replaced by an on-line processing system by the VAX-11/750 computer system, which belonged to the Computer Services Center. Students had to assemble at the Male Dormitory 1 (currently the Faculty of Political Sciences and Public Administrations building) to request enrollment.

In 1989, the <u>Registration Office was established</u> as a government sector of Chiang Mai University to support expansion and academic progress. It was a center for academic coordinations and supports, starting from admissions, class schedule assignments, enrollments, academic result processing, verification of graduation and issuing academic documents.

THE FOURTH DECADE (1994-2003)

For the agility in administrations, Fiber Optic cables were wired from the Computer Services Center to the Registration Office, and the enrollment system was developed using the LAN(Local Area Network) within the Registration Office.

In 1999, the Registration Office developed an Internet-based course enrollment/adding/withdrawal system, starting from the second semester of academic year 1999, in order to make the procedure more flexible, convenient and effective. Students could log in at any time to check the result of enrollment. Moreover, the system allowed the faculties/departments to expand the capacity to meet the demands of students.

THE FIFTH DECADE (2004-2013)

During this decade, the Registration Office developed a fully online Registration Systems, with services including completing student records, requesting for a leave of absence, requesting for resignation, requesting for course withdrawal with a grade of W, etc.

In 2013, the Registration Office developed a <u>Mobile Application</u> to provide services related to the registration information systems to students and advisors via smart devices, i.e. class schedules, exam schedules, academic results and calculation of academic results, etc.

<u>The Registration Counter Service (RCS)</u> was launched on November 18, 2011, with a goal to create a One Stop Service spot for registration-related activities, such as making academic fee payments and registering for graduation.
