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Registration for New Graduate Students

Starting semester 2/2022, new students can verify their identity through the NDID system (Thais only) and apply for a student ID card in the SCB Easy App. Please visit https://cmu.to/FyRHc for more information.

Applicants who have already registered as new students and paid the tuition fees must enroll for course(s) or register for university service within the date and time specified in the 2022 Academic Calendar for complete registration.

Getting to know "I" grade

What is "I" grade?

Letter grade "I" means **incomplete** measurement, which is granted to those who are not able to get evaluated within the designated time. Meanwhile, letter grade "P" means the course's teaching is still

in progress.

How to request for the "I" grade?

Visit the Registration Office's website, log in with your CMU account, then follow each step in the handbook to make a request. You can request for letter grade "I" for courses that you have successfully enrolled in. To defer evaluation and request for letter grade "I", you must obtain approval from the instructor and the dean of faculty offering the course, and submit proofs of necessity e.g. a medical certificate.

What to do after receiving "I" grade?

- You must enroll for courses/register for university service in order to replace the "I" grade. Undergraduates must be evaluated within 30 days after the starting date of the following semester, while graduate students must be evaluated before the last two weeks of a regular semester. If not, you will receive the letter grade "F" or "U" instead.
- Repeated enrollment for the course is not required.
- After evaluation and measurement, the replacement grade will show up in the enrolled semester's final grade result. Noted that the "I" grade will still appear in your transcript despite being replaced.

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CMU Admission through 2023 TCAS and IPAS




